- After you answer, I'll give you a correct answer.

This process will continue and little by little; I'll be telling a story using questions and answers.

Ok, let's get started!

**Last summer George and Peter were planning their summer holidays. Their first idea was to visit Hawaii. They loved Hawaii!**

*Did George and Peter want to visit New York?*

No, they didn't want to visit New York. They wanted to visit Hawaii.

*What did they want to visit last summer?*

Hawaii. George and Peter wanted to visit Hawaii.

*Who wanted visit Hawaii?*

George and Peter. They wanted to visit Hawaii.

*Did they hate Hawaii?*

No, no. They loved Hawaii!

*When was that? Last summer? Last winter?*

Last summer. It was last summer. George and Peter wanted to visit Hawaii last summer.

**Sadly George and Peter didn't have enough money to visit Hawaii. They thought about swimming to Hawaii, but they were too lazy.**

*Did George and Peter swim to Hawaii last summer?*

No, George and Peter didn't swim to Hawaii.

*Where did they want to swim last summer?*

To Hawaii. George and Peter wanted to swim to Hawaii.

*Why didn't George and Peter swim to Hawaii?*

They didn't swim to Hawaii because they were too lazy.

*Did George and Peter swim to Hawaii?*

No, no. They didn't swim to Hawaii.

*Did they swim to New York?*

No, no. They didn't swim to New York. They thought about swimming to Hawaii.

*Who didn't swim to Hawaii last summer? Who? Santa Claus?*

*No! Not Santa. It was George and Peter who didn't swim to Hawaii last summer. They were too lazy.*

*When did George and Peter want to swim to Hawaii? When?*

Last summer. They wanted to swim to Hawaii last summer.

**George and Peter also wanted to go to the gym every day last summer. They didn't go to the gym eventually because they were lazy.**

*Did George and Peter go to the gym every day last summer?*

No. They didn't go to the gym every day last summer.

*Who didn't go to the gym every day last summer?*

George and Peter. They didn't go to the gym last summer.

*Why didn't George and Peter go to the gym?*

They didn't go to the gym because they were too lazy.

*Did George and Peter go to the beach every day last summer?*

No, no. George and Peter didn't go to the beach every day last summer. They didn't go to the gym either.

*Where did George and Peter want to go every day last summer?*

To the gym. They wanted to go to the gym every day last summer.

**Last summer George and Peter wanted to listen to their favorite English podcast. Finally, they didn't do that either. They were too lazy.**

*Did George and Peter listen to their favorite English podcast last summer?*

No. They didn't. They didn't listen to their favorite English podcast last summer.

*Did George and Peter watch English movies last summer?*

No, no. They didn't watch English movies last summer.

*Why didn't George and Peter listen to their favorite English podcast?*

Because they were too lazy. George and Peter didn't listen to their favorite English podcast because they were too lazy.

*Who didn't listen to their favorite English podcast last summer?*

George and Peter. They didn't listen to their favorite English podcast last summer because they were too lazy.

*What didn't they do last summer?*

George and Peter didn't listen to their favorite English podcast last summer.

**George and Peter didn't swim to Hawaii, didn't go to the gym every day, and they didn't listen to their favorite English podcast either.**

**Instead, they've slept all summer long! They were too lazy and of course they didn't improve their English!**

Ok, it's the end of this short story.
